Michael H. Fogel, Psy.D., ABPP, is a licensed clinical psychologist who is Board Certified in Forensic Psychology by the American Board of Professional Psychology (ABPP). He is a member of the Board of Directors of the American Board of Forensic Psychology (ABFP), which is the ABPP specialty board responsible for the certifying process in forensic psychology, the ABFP National Chair of Examinations, and ABFP President-Elect for 2013. Dr. Fogel also serves on the American Psychological Association's (APA) Committee on Professional Practice and Standards, which is primarily responsible for the creation and review of practice standards and guidelines promulgated by APA.

Dr. Fogel has extensive experience authoring forensic psychological evaluation reports and providing expert witness testimony in both civil and criminal matters. He has completed forensic psychological evaluations in several states and at the federal level. Furthermore, he has had the unique experience of having worked in correctional settings at the county, state, and federal levels.

Dr. Fogel is an Associate Professor in the Department of Forensic Psychology at The Chicago School of Professional Psychology. In August 2010, he transitioned to his current position after serving as Chair of the department for over three years.
